

UPM Timber in brief

UPM Timber produces redwood and whitewood sawn timber for construction, packaging, furniture and joinery industries. UPM Timber operates four sawmills in Finland located in Pietarsaari (Alholma), Lappeenranta (Kaukas), Juupajoki (Korkeakoski) and Pori (Seikku). The annual production capacity is 1.5 million cubic metres of sawn timber. UPM Timber business has around 440 employees and is part of UPM Biorefining business area.



UPM Pietarsaari mill integrate

UPM Alholma sawmill is located in UPM Pietarsaari mill integrate together with UPM pulp mill, Billerud Korsnäs paper mill and Alholmens Kraft power plan. The mill site covers in total about 200 hectares. The near-by Pietarsaari harbor plays an important role in the export of forest products.

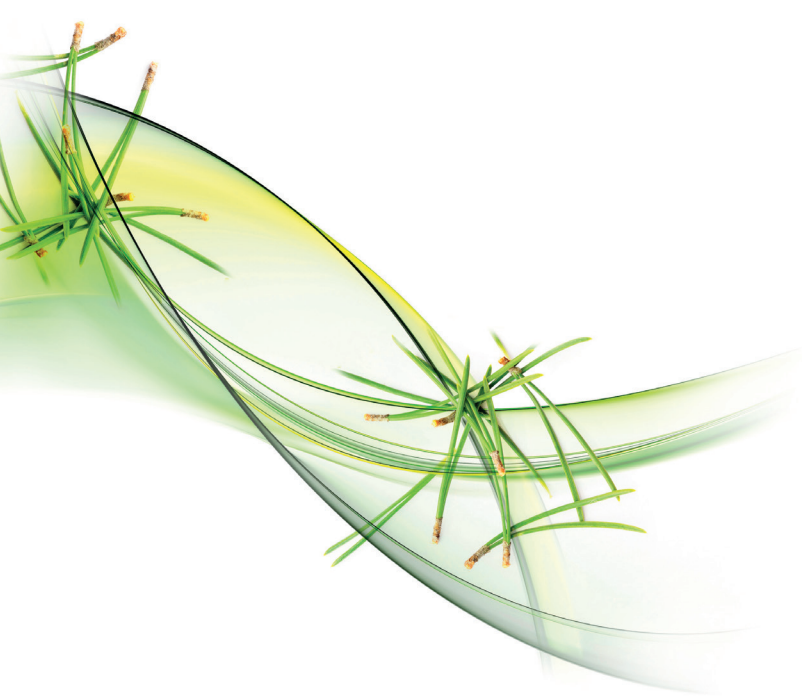

UPM Alholma sawmill

Alholma sawmill is one of the four sawmills UPM Timber operates in Finland. The sawmill has a long history dating back to 1896. Today the sawmill produces standard and special sawn timber of Nordic spruce and pine. The annual production capacity of Alholma sawmill is 250,000 m³ of sawn timber.

Approximately two thirds of the sawn timber produced in Alholma sawmill are exported. The main export markets are Asia and Middle East – North African countries. Finland is the largest single market for Alholma sawmill.

As raw material, Alholma sawmill uses 100 % domestic spruce and pine purchased mainly from the forests of Ostrobothnia, Central Finland and Kainuu. UPM is committed to sustainable forest management and forestry methods based on internationally accepted principles. All sawn timber produced at UPM Timber sawmills fulfil the requirements of PEFC™ and FSC® Controlled Wood certification.
